I learn from the Scriptures that there is one living God (1. Tim. 2:5; ch. 4:14), I fully revealed to us in Christ (John 1:18), and known through Him as Father, Son, and Holy Ghost (Matt. 3:16,17; ch. 28:19; Eph. 2:18), in the unity of the Godhead (John 5:19; 1.
